



# Walkability Assessment Checklist

Use this Walkability Checklist to assess the routes you've mapped or walked. The items below will help you think about how you safe and comfortable you feel along the route, and if there needs to be changes to the suggested walking routes for the employees. Most walking routes will not have all of the items listed below, but it is important to assess whether employees will overall feel safe and comfortable walking along the routes.

## Sidewalks

Is the sidewalk wide enough for wheelchairs or people walking two or three abreast?
