# OTHER STATE EXAMPLES

---

- **FLORIDA: Toll Credits**
  - Similar to Ohio
  - Talk to your state SRTS coordinator, bike/ped coordinator, etc.
- **OREGON: Bits and Pieces**
  - Percentage covered by western states public lands benefit
  - Looked at SAFETEA-LU projects together with MAP-21:
    - Local voluntary match covered some
    - SAFETEA-LU covered some (no match required)
    - State funds leveraged to cover a few ineligible matches
